Kissed by Inspiration, a film set in the 1950s, was accepted into the 10th annual Big Apple Film Festival in New York City. The festival runs November 6-10 2013, and it will feature the film's world premiere. The film will screen at Tribeca Cinemas on November 8th at 10pm (in shorts block 11) - tickets are currently on sale on the festival's website, http://www.bigapplefilmfestival.com.

The movie is produced by Canton Theatrical, LLC, written by Kevin Christopher Snipes, with original concept by Anthony J. Cantalupo. Anthony is currently developing Ride... A Pop Fable, a new musical by Damon Intrabartolo which plans to open in Orlando in 2014. The concept was developed by Cantalupo and Marissa Kelton, who acts as one of the lead characters. Kissed tells the story of an ad-campaign that is fighting for survival.

"I've always loved the look of the 1950s and 60s. It's been my dream to work on a period piece, so I figured, why not create my own movie?" says Kelton. "I'm hoping this project will be a stepping stone for working on bigger projects set in that time period."
